"Woe to you experts in the law! You have taken away the key to knowledge. You didn't go in yourselves, and you hindered those who were trying to go in." **Luke 11:52 (CSB)**

When he left there, the scribes and the Pharisees began to oppose him fiercely and to cross-examine him about many things; 54 they were lying in wait for him to trap him in something he said. **Luke 11:53 (CSB)**

Meanwhile, a crowd of many thousands came together, so that they were trampling on one another.
