KEEP SOME PRINTED RESOURCES HANDY

Things like modern gospel tracks or an easy-to-read New Testament that you can give away can be helpful.

• WRITE OUT YOUR STORY AND PRACTICE TELLING IT

Many Christians have a great story but have a terrible delivery. Practice telling people your story without Christian-ese in a simple, powerful, and concise way. If it's too long, you'll lose them.

• LEARN HOW TO RESPOND TO SOME OF THE MOST COMMON OBJECTIONS

THREE THINGS YOU CAN DO TO BE A GOOD SAMARITAN WITH THE GOSPEL

- 1. INTERCEDE DAILY FOR THE LOST AND FOR GOD TO USE YOU
- PRAY FOR THE LOST BY NAME

• PRAY FOR BOLDNESS

Praying at all times... that words may be given to me in opening my mouth boldly to proclaim the mystery of the gospel. **Ephesians 6: 18-19 (ESV)**

• PRAY FOR GOOD OPPORTUNITIES

Pray also for us, so that God will give us a **good opportunity** to preach his message about the secret of Christ. **Colossians 4:3 (GNT)**

2. INVEST SOMETHING IN THE LIVES OF LOST PEOPLE

3. INVITE PEOPLE TO CHURCH

Andrew, Simon Peter's brother, was one of the two who heard what John the Baptist had said and who had followed Jesus. The **first thing** Andrew did was to find his brother Simon and tell him, "We have found the Messiah" (that is, the Christ). And **he brought him to Jesus**. **John 1:40-42 (NIV)**
